## WINEMAKING

The fruit for our Cabernet Sauvignon comes from the Beller Vineyard on Mt. Veeder. It is a co-ferment of Cabernet Sauvignon Clone 169 and Petit Verdot. The grapes were harvested on September 25, 2017, just 11 days before the vineyard was surrounded by wildfire. The grapes were fermented using indigenous yeasts and malolactic bacteria, and the wine was aged in thin-staved Bordeaux chateau barrels with *soutirage traditionnel* every 3 months.

## TASTING NOTES

The 2017 Cabernet Sauvignon, Beller Vineyard has a dark garnet color with purple to brick hues. On the nose, it displays fresh blueberry, raspberry, violet, graphite, mesquite, spearmint and leather. On the palate, the wine enters with bright blueberry and blackberry fruit, followed by a rich mid-palate and well-integrated tannins. The progression of this wine is seamless, leading to a long finish of fresh fruit and herbs.
