WINEMAKING

The fruit for our Pinot Noir comes from 8 rows of vines planted with the Pisoni clone from the legendary Soberanes Vineyard located on the western edge of the Salinas Valley. The grapes were picked in the early morning hours of August 25, 2017 and were immediately transported to Napa for crushing. The wine was fermented using indigenous yeast and malolactic bacteria with punch downs twice a day, followed by 12 months of aging in neutral Burgundy barrels. The wine was bottled in September 2018 without filtration.

TASTING NOTES

The 2017 Complant Pinot Noir, Soberanes Vineyard has a red rose petal color. On the nose, complex aromas of sour cherry, pomegranate, raspberry, bay, thyme and tobacco lift from the glass. On the palate, this dynamic wine displays flavors of red fruit with great acid balance, and an exceptionally long finish.
