WINEMAKING

The fruit for our Pinot Noir comes from 8 rows of vines planted with the Pisoni clone from the legendary Soberanes Vineyard located on the western edge of the Salinas Valley. The grapes were picked in the early morning hours of September 5, 2018 and were immediately transported to Napa for crushing. The wine was fermented using indigenous yeast and malolactic bacteria with punch downs twice a day, followed by 12 months of aging in neutral Burgundy barrels on its lees.

TASTING NOTES

The 2018 Complant Pinot Noir, Soberanes Vineyard has a cherry red color and a nose of pomegranate, cranberry and raspberry bramble. The palate opens with a savory, almost briny, entry that transitions to cranberry and pomegranate flavors with a slight grip on the finish. The wine has an unusual combination of lacy texture coupled with incredible persistence on the palate, with flavors that linger long after the wine leaves the mouth. With time in the glass, the nose continues to evolve and expresses sea breeze and bing cherry.
