### WINEMAKING

The fruit for our Pinot Noir comes from 8 rows of vines planted with the Pisoni clone from the legendary Soberanes Vineyard located on the western edge of the Salinas Valley. The grapes were picked in the early morning hours of September 4, 2019 and were immediately transported to Napa for crushing. 85% of the fruit was destemmed, leaving 15% whole cluster. The wine was fermented using indigenous yeast and malolactic bacteria with punch downs twice a day, followed by 12 months of aging in neutral Burgundy barrels on its lees.

### TASTING NOTES

The 2019 Complant Pinot Noir, Soberanes Vineyard, Santa Lucia Highlands has a red sapphire color and an expressive nose of pomegranate, cranberry and hints of tarragon and pine resin. The wine is fruit-sweet and lively on the palate with notes of red fruit, spice, savory spice and dried rose petals. It has an extremely long finish with a lovely acid balance and a slight grip.
